Halloween Fun Facts

Halloween is always on October 31, the night before a holiday called All Saints' Day.



The word "Halloween" comes from "All Hallows' Eve." "Eve" means the evening before.



Trick-or-treating became popular in the United States in the 1930s. That is almost 100 years ago.



A pumpkin is really a fruit, not a vegetable. It is a kind of squash and it is full of seeds.



The first jack-o'-lanterns were not pumpkins. In Ireland, people carved turnips!



Bats are the only mammals (animals with fur that feed their babies milk) that can really fly.



Spiders are not insects. Insects have 6 legs, but spiders have 8.



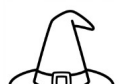
Candy corn was invented in the 1880s. It is shaped like a kernel of corn but made of sugar.

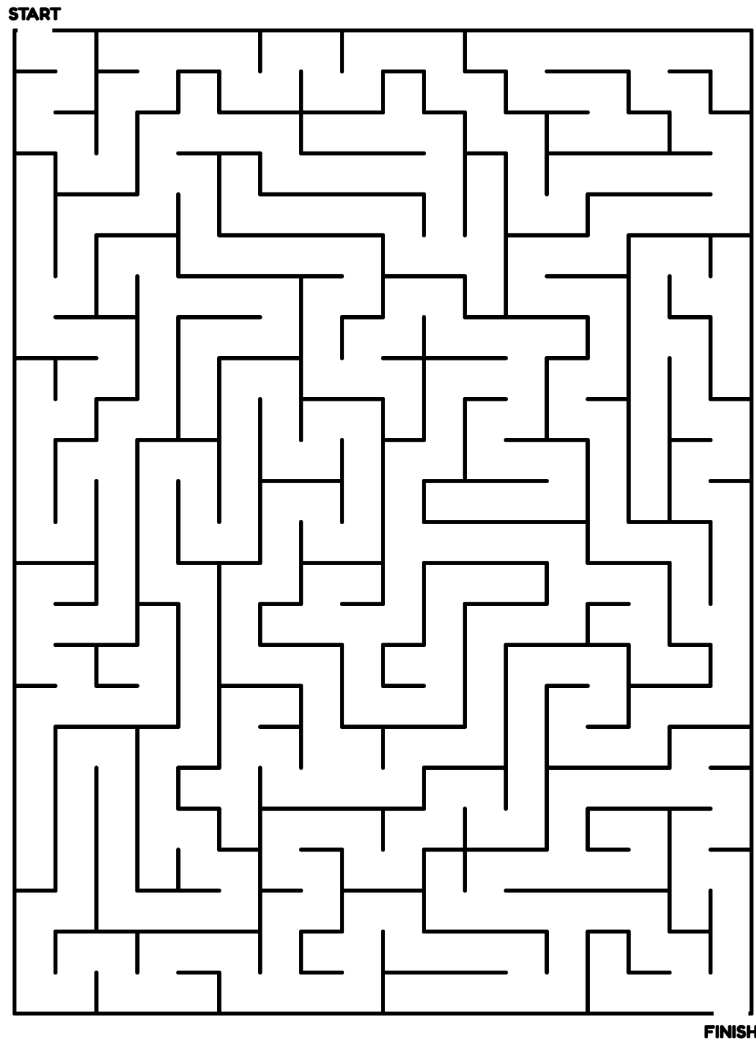

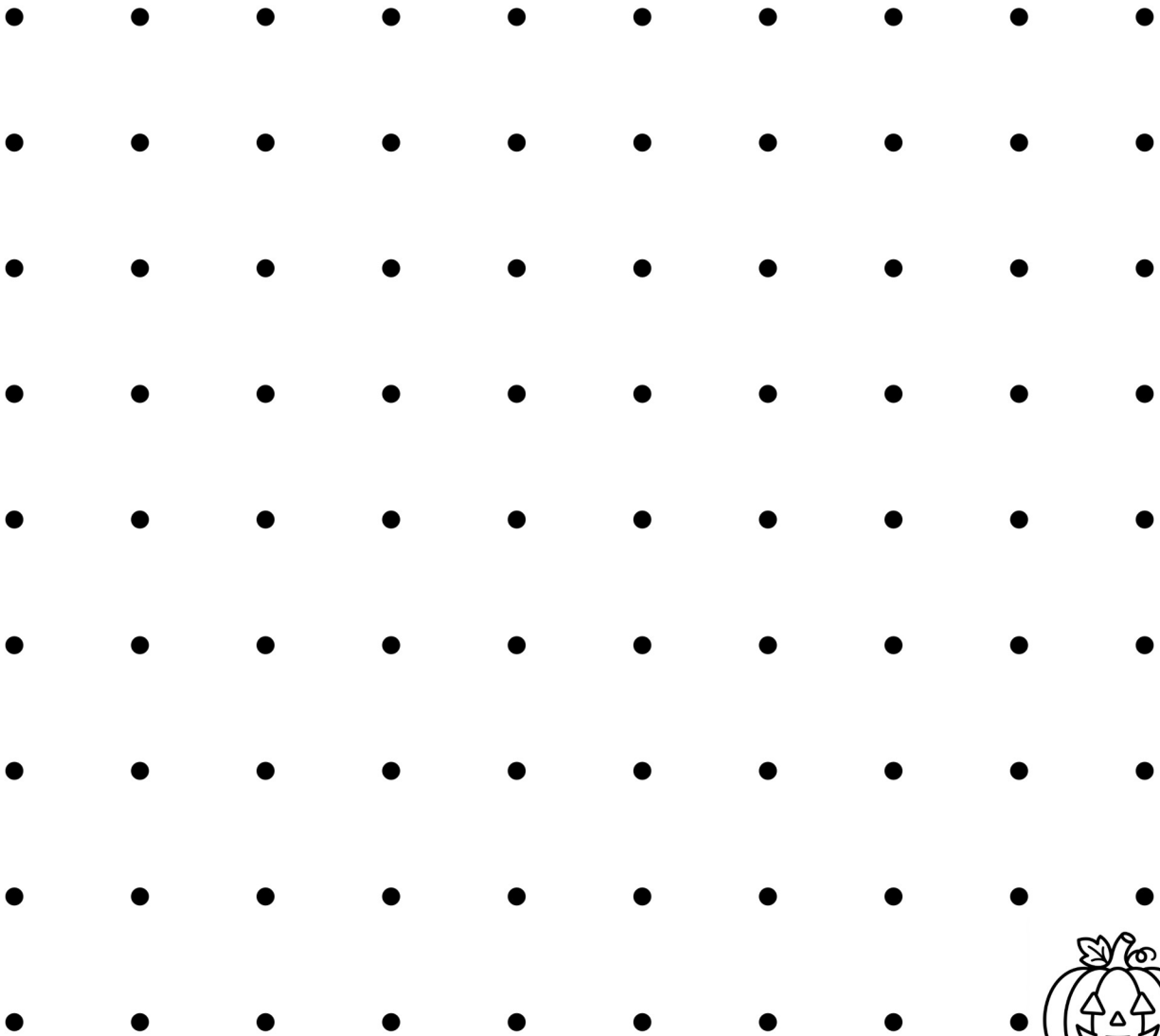

A game for two. Read the rules at the bottom and play!

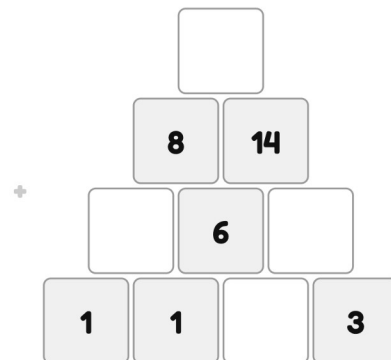
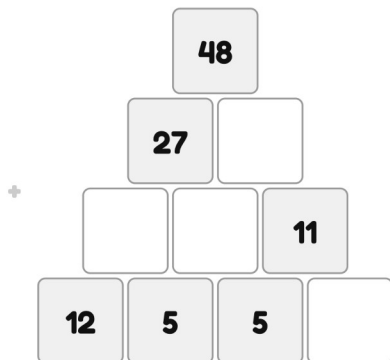
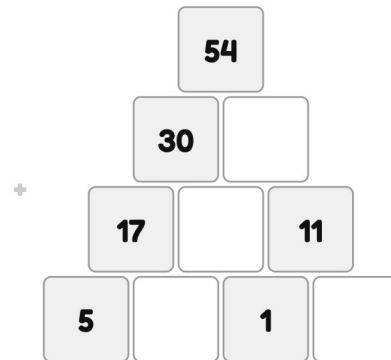
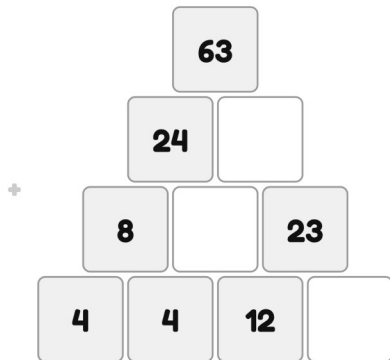


How to play Dots and Boxes (2 players)
